Sub: Convergence of efforts by different departments of Government to assist IFR title holders including coverage under the Rural Housing Schemes.

Madam/ Sir,

It is evident from the reports received from the ST & SC Development Department indicating the position at the end of February, 2019 that as many as 6,15,741 Individual Forest Rights (IFR) claims have been submitted by the Forest Rights Committees (FRCs) for suitable action at SDLC and DLC levels. Though the DLCs have already approved 4,38,676 claims for distribution of certificates of titles, so far only 4,27,889 certificates of titles have been distributed.

2. As per the norms laid down by the Government, these IFR title holders are to be accorded the top most priority in the matter of assistance under various rural housing schemes like IAY/ PMAY, Mo Kudia, Biju Pucca Ghar Yojana etc. But the ground realities are really very discouraging as may be seen from the statement enclosed herewith as Annexure-A. Out of 4,27,889 IFR title holders, only 1,53,306 (35.83%) households have been assisted under various rural housing schemes. The percentage of coverage in 10 districts like Bolangir (18.32%), Deogarh (22.36%), Dhenkanal (28.99%), Jajpur (7.22%), Jharsuguda (20.04%), Mayurbhanj (9.27%), Nabarangpur (25.91%), Nayagarh (22.90%), Sambalpur (27.65%) and Sundargarh (21.55%) is highly unsatisfactory.

3. Going by the absolute numbers, there is a huge gap for coverage of such deserving title holders in 10 districts namely Mayurbhanj (46,146), Keonjhar (37,321), Kandhamal (33,850), Nabarangpur (30,208), Gajapati (17,792), Sundargarh (15,193), Koraput (14,626), Malkangiri (12,934), Rayagada (12,423) and Sambalpur (9,864). Out of the total shortfall of 2,74,582, these 10 districts account for 2,30,357 (83.89%). Therefore, it is urgently required to focus attention on these 10 districts to assist as many IFR title holders as possible under the rural housing schemes.

4. As it appears, these issues have not been brought to the notice of the Government in Panchayati Raj & D.W. Department for their consideration to carry out the mandate available in this regard. Needless to mention that the IFR title holders are among the most vulnerable households in our State. Therefore, it would be just and proper to assist these households with a view to enabling them to live with dignity. You are requested to report the progress achieved till the end of March, 2019 preferably by the end of April, 2019.
