Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 31.3.2020]

Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act:

- (i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in Annexure-I. As per the information collected till now, 42,51,545 claims (41,02,437 individual and 1,49,108 community claims) have been filed and 19,83,504 titles (19,07,126 individual and 76,378 community claims) have been distributed.
- (ii) A total of 37,36,057 (87.88%) claims have been disposed of. It may be seen that there is decrease of 3600 claims being shown as disposed off in March, 2020 cumulatively compared to the previous month. The number of disposed off claims are seen to decrease only in Odisha. The reasons for the same were obtained from the State Government which has clarified that claims rejected earlier are under review and therefore, the number of claims disposed of has decreased.
- (iii) A statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in Annexure-II, is being maintained.

The inhabitants of the State are predominantly tribal with distinct linguistic, culture, tradition, customs and socio- political characteristics and also the land and Forests belongs to the private individuals, clans or community in the villages and land holding and resources therein are governed by traditional and customary practices of the people. That the said Article also specifically provides that No Act of Parliament in respect of ownership and transfer of land and its resources, shall apply to the State of Nagaland unless the Legislative Assembly of Nagaland by a resolution so decides. That in view of the said provision of the Constitution, there is no resolution passed by the Legislative Assembly to make the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act 2006 applicable to the State of Nagaland
