Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 30.09.2019]

### Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act:

(i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in Annexure-I. As per the information collected till now, 42,40,134 claims (40,91,308 individual and 1,48,826 community claims) have been filed and 19,69,461 titles (18,93,299 individual and 76,162 community claims) have been distributed. A total of 37,23,058 (87.81%) claims have been disposed of. A statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in Annexure-II, is being maintained.
