## 1. Regarding Court cases filed against the Act:

- (I) Writ Petition (Civil) No. 50 of 2008, Writ Petition Civil No.109 of 2008, Transfer Petitions Civil No.414-417/ 2008 and Transfer Petitions Civil No.179-180/ 2009, came up for hearing on 2.03.2009 in the Hon'ble Supreme Court. From the Government side, Shri Fali. S. Nariman, Senior Advocate and Shri Mohan Parasaran, Ld. Additional Solicitor General of India, besides other Advocates were present during the hearing. Hon'ble Court ordered to post the matter before a three-judge Bench. These cases have been listed for hearing on 27.04.2009.
- (II) Two officers of this Ministry visited Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh on 26th and 27th March, 2009 to file Counter Affidavit in the Writ Petition No.4656 of 2008 filed by Shri Rajesh Jauhri in the High Court of Judicature of Madhya Pradesh Bench at Indore, which was later transferred to Principal Bench of M.P. High Court at Jabalpur. The Counter Affidavit was filed on 28.03.2009. During their interaction with the Assistant Director (Legal) of Tribal Development, Govt. of MP, stationed at Jabalpur, it was known that three more Writ Petitions have been filed before the Principal Bench of the Madhya Pradesh High Court at Jabalpur against the Forest Right Act, The Ministry of Tribal Affairs is a respondent in all the three cases. However, this fact was not conveyed to this Ministry either by the State Government of Madhya Pradesh or by Central Government standing counsel. Filing of Counter Affidavits on behalf of the Union of India in all the three new cases is under process in the Ministry.

## 2. Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act:

An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in Annexure-I. As per the information collected from the States till 31st March, 2009, more than 20.50 lakhs claims have been filed and about 1.53 lakhs titles have been distributed. More than 1.93 lakhs titles are ready for distribution. Pending population of the web-site (www.forestrights.gov.in), a statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in Annexure-II, is being maintained. Both Annexures I and II are also being put up on the Ministry's web-site.

## 3. Legal clarifications sought by the States, if any:

A meeting of the Core Group was held on 24.03.2009 under the Chairmanship of Secretary (TA), to consider the various issues related to the implementation of the Forest Rights Act, 2006. Representatives of Ministry of Environment & Forests, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and Ministry of Law & Justice (Department of Legal Affairs) also attended the meeting:

## 4. Matters relating to the Act pending at the level of Government of India:

The guidelines for diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government under section 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, have been finalized in consultation with the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Ministry of Panchayati Raj, Ministry of Law and Justice and Department of Land Resources. The same shall be issued after the modal code of conduct ceases to be in operation.
