Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 31st March, 2010]

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1. <u>Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act</u> :

An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in Annexure-I. As per the information collected till 31st March 2010, more than 27.44 lakh claims have been filed and more than 7.82 lakh titles have been distributed. More than 31 thousand titles were ready for distribution.

State-wise synopsis of claims disposed of, as on 31.03.10, with respect to the total number of claims received up to May 09, the month of announcement of special drive, is as below:

- (ii) Progress of implementation of the Act relating to the number of claims received and number of claims disposed of in the above mentioned States from the month of July, 09 to the current month has been shown in the Trend Charts in **Annexure-III**. From the said trend charts, it is inferred that the States of Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Uttar Pradesh and Tripura have tapered of in the number of claims received and number of claims disposed off. The States of Assam, Gujarat, Karnataka, Jharkhand, Kerala, Orissa, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu and West Bengal have tapered off in the number of claims received. In the States of Bihar and Uttarakhand number of claims filed so far is very little.
