
Sir,

This is to inform that the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, under Section-12 of the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA 2006) has issued guidelines regarding the implementation of the said Act on 12.7.2012. The Ministry of Tribal Affairs has also made some amendments to the Forest Rights Rules, 2008 which have been notified in Gazette of India on 19.7.2006. These actions have been initiated to ensure effective implementation of the Forest Rights Act.
