#### Government of India Ministry of Tribal Affairs

Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2010]

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- 1. <u>Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act</u> :
  - (i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in Annexure-I. As per the information collected till 30<sup>th</sup> September 2010, more than 29.75 lakh claims have been filed and more than 10.33 lakh titles have been distributed. More than 30 thousand titles were ready for distribution.

Pending population of the web-site (<u>www.forestrights.gov.in</u>), a statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in **Annexure-II**, is being maintained.

(iii) Progress of implementation of the Act relating to the number of claims received and number of claims disposed of in the above mentioned States from the month of July, 09 to the current month has been shown in the Trend Charts in **Annexure-III**. From the said trend charts, it is seen that in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, the number of claims received has reached a plateau. In the States of Bihar, Jharkhand, and Uttarakhand the number of claims filed so far is still very little.

- (iv) Progress in implementation of the Act relating to the number of claims received and the number of titles distributed in the LWE affected States has separately been shown in **Annexure-IV**.

#### 5. <u>Monitoring of the implementation of the Act:</u>

(i) A consultative meeting of Working Group Members of National Advisory Council was held on 7<sup>th</sup> September, 2010 at TRIFED Conference Hall, NCUI Building, August Kranti Marg, New Delhi for discussion on Tribal Development. Dr. Ram Dayal Munda, M.P., Member, NAC; Dr. Rita Sharma, Secretary, NAC; Shri A. K. Chugh, Secretary, Ministry of Tribal Affairs; Shri A. N. P. Sinha, Secretary, Ministry of Panchayati Raj; Dr. Bachittar Singh, Joint Secretary, Ministry of Tribal Affairs; Shri A. K. Srivastava, Director, Ministry of Tribal Affairs; representatives of Ministries of Environment & Forests and Rural Development; representatives of some selected State Governments; Experts and Members of various Civil Societies & organizations from various States participated in that meeting. Dr. Bachittar Singh made a power point presentation on the implementation of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 which was followed by discussion amongst the participants on the various aspects of implementation of the Act.

- (ii) A meeting was taken by Dr. Bachittar Singh, Joint Secretary, along with Shri A. K. Srivastava, Director in the Ministry on 13.09.2010, at Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi with the representatives of State Governments of Andhra Pradesh and Maharashtra to discuss the issues related to the implementation of the Forest Rights Act. During the deliberations in the meeting, it was, inter-alia, stressed to take expeditious steps to speed up the implementation of the Forest Rights Act, particularly, for inviting more community claims and their subsequent expeditious adjudication. Other issues that were also discussed concerned release of funds under Article 275 (1) of the Constitution and SCA to TSP.
- (iii) Shri A. K. Srivastava, Director in the Ministry, visited States of Orissa and Tamil Nadu during the month of September, 2010 and inter-alia, reviewed the implementation of the Forest Rights Act, 2006 in those States.
- (iv) Letters issued by Hon'ble Minster of Tribal Affairs, on 27.09.2010, to Chief Ministers of Tripura and Uttar Pradesh, requesting them to:
  - (a) Launch special campaign for generating wide-spread awareness to invite and facilitate collection of more community rights claims;
  - (b) Take action for convergence of Government programmes for the development and welfare of tribals;
  - (c) Take action for diversion of forest land for development activities as provided under Section 3(2) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006;

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- (d) Take action for determination and notification of critical wildlife habitats in the National Parks and Sanctuaries as provided under Section 2(b) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006;
- (e) Take action for conversion of forest villages into revenue villages as provided under Section 3(1)(h) of the Forest Rights Act, 2006.
