

Rights and Concessions in Padmapur ex-Anchal

+ (Borasambar ex-Estate)

Reserved species	.. Nil
Cess	.. Halapati— Re. 0-8-0 annually for each plough for tenants Chulapati (for landless)— Re. 0-8-0 for each chula or hearth for landless tenants

Rajgiri (Professionals)—

- Rs. 2-0-0 for each Blacksmith, Keot, Goldsmith and Po-sma-er
- Rs. 3-0-0 for a Blacksmith who smelt Pig iron
- Re. 1-0-0 for each Wash-woman
- Re. 1-0-0 for a Chammar woman
- Rs. 1-8-0 for Chammar
- Rs. 1-8-0 for a Washman—Actually Rs. 2 is collected.

In ex-Anchal Forests (Zaminwajy Rajgiri)

Timber	.. On payment of fees
Firewood	.. The tenants who pay 'Rajgiri' Halapati and Chulapati are allowed free.
Bamboo	.. On payment of license fees
M. P. F.	.. The tenants who pay Rajgiri, Halapati and Chulapati are allowed leaves, bunch grass, thorns and fruits free.
Grazing	.. No free grazing
