

M.P. panel to review Bhoodan land allotment

Bhopal: The Madhya Pradesh government has decided to set up a committee to review allotment of land during Bhoodan Movement.

"There will be a committee to review the allotment of land during the Bhoodan Movement. Action would be initiated against those found guilty in transferring Scheduled Tribes land to non- Scheduled Tribes in the state", Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan said addressing a Land Rights Convention here yesterday

Chief Minister said that encroachment of land forming cooperatives in the name of farmers and scheduled tribes would also be probed.

Besides, Nazul officers would be appointed for effective implementation of Scheduled Tribes and Traditional Forest Dwellers (Forest Rights Act), he said.

Asserting that the state government was committed to remove difficulties coming in the way of implementation of Forest Rights Act, he said to achieve desired objectives Principal Secretary Tribal Affairs O P Rawat have been appointed.
