Status report on implementation of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 [for the period ending 31st July, 2010]

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1. Readiness of the States in the implementation of the Act :

- (i) An updated status of State-wise implementation of the Act is given in **Annexure-I**. As per the information collected till 31st July 2010, 28.49 lakh claims **have been filed and more than 9.93 lakh titles have been distributed. More than 27 thousand titles were ready for distribution.**

Pending population of the web-site (www.foresights.gov.in), a statement on claims received and distribution of title deeds in various states, as in **Annexure-II**, are being maintained.

- (iii) Progress of implementation of the Act relating to the number of claims received and number of claims disposed of in the above mentioned States from the month of July, 09 to the current month has been shown in

the Trend Charts in **Annexure-III**. From the said trend charts, it is seen that in the States of Andhra Pradesh, Assam, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Orissa, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh and West Bengal, the number of claims received has reached a plateau. In the States of Bihar, Jharkhand, and Uttarakhand the number of claims filed so far is still very little.

- (iv) Progress in implementation of the Act relating to the number of claims received and the number of titles distributed in the LWE affected States has separately been shown in **Annexure-IV**.

5. Monitoring of the implementation of the Act:

- (i). Dr. Bachittar Singh, Joint Secretary in the Ministry, visited Uttar Pradesh on 1st July, 2010 and reviewed the implementation of the Forest Rights Act,

2006 in the State, along with the Principal Secretary, Social Welfare Department, Principal Secretary (Forests) & Conservator of Forests Government of Uttar Pradesh.

(ii) Hon'ble Minister of Tribal Affairs, along with Dr. Bachittar Singh, Joint Secretary in the Ministry, visited the State of Assam from 4th to 6th July, 2010 and reviewed the implementation of the Forest Right Act in the State.

(iii) Oral Evidence was held before the Parliamentary Standing Committee of Social Justice & Empowerment, on 8th July, 2010. Secretary Tribal Affairs and other senior officers of the Ministry along with the concern officers from Ministry of Environment & Forests attended the Oral Evidence.

(iv) Hon'ble Minister of State, Tribal Affairs along with Dr. Bachittar Singh, Joint Secretary in the Ministry, visited the State of Rajasthan on 15th July, 2010 and reviewed the implementation of the Forest Right Act in the State.

Barring few pockets of land under wildlife sanctuaries, reserved forests, most of the land in entire State is community land. Territorial boundaries of land and forest belonging to different communities or tribes are also identified in the same line leaving no scope for any dispute over the possession of land, forest and water bodies among the tribes. Therefore, Forest Rights Act does not have much relevance in Arunachal Pradesh.	-

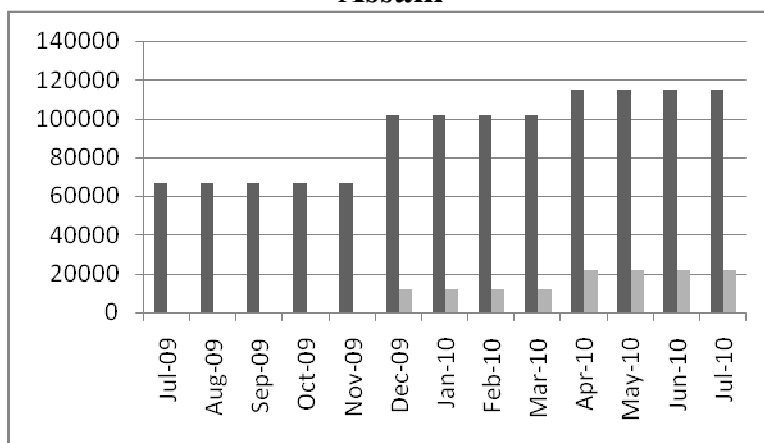

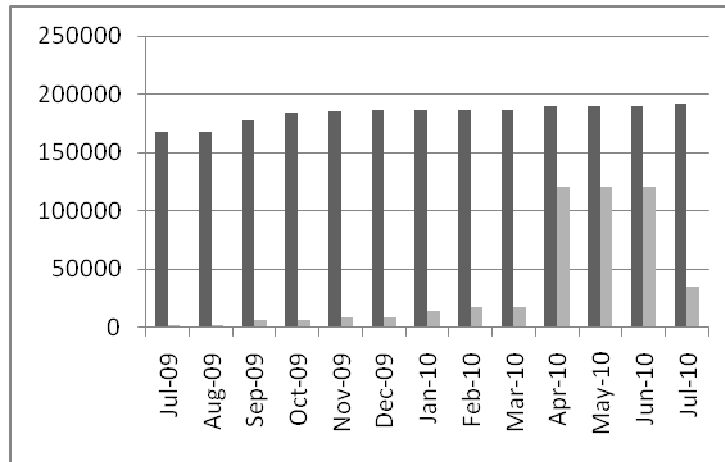

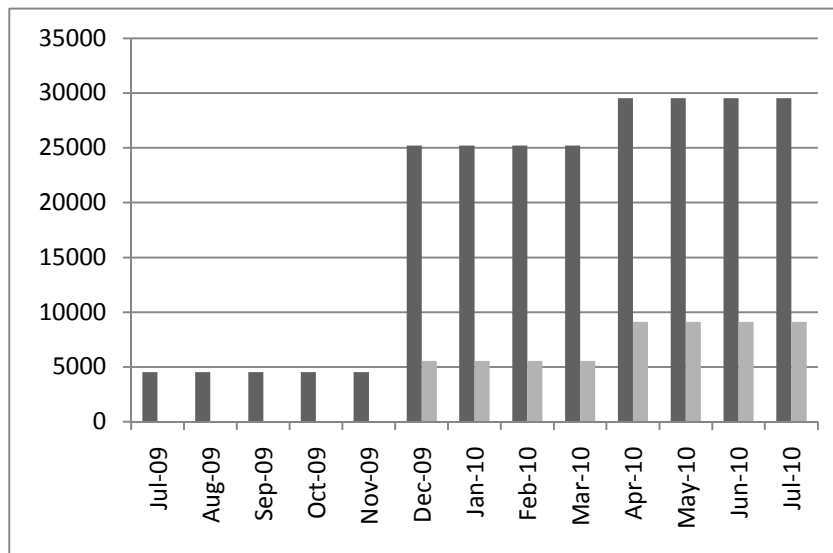
