# **Action Plan for Training and Awareness Raising on FRA**

- Gram Sabha/Van Adhikar Samiti being the first level of adjudication, Act and rules have been translated in different tribal dialects (Korku, Bhili, Gondi) to make the law/rules understandable to illiterate tribal members.
- Publication of booklets of amended Rules 2012.
- Training of master trainers at district level- Dec. 2012
- Refreshers courses to reorient the field officials.
- Training to field functionary-Jan. 2012

# **Action Plan for formation of Forest Rights Committees**

- All the District/sub-divisions/villages near forest area have been listed.
- The list of hamlets/habitations is being prepared.
- The list of hamlets/habitations will be prepared in phases till December, 2012.
- The FRCs in the hamlets/habitations will be constituted simultaneously.
- Presently, 27145 FRCs have been constituted.

## Formation of DLC and SDLC

- 50 DLSs & 197 SDLCs have been formed.
- All DLCs & SDLs have been formed,  
Amendments will be notified by jan.2013.

# Action Plan for Community Forest Resource Rights

- In the radius of 5 k.m. from the forest boundary 27145 villages have been identified.
- So far 13093 CFR rights have been claimed from 6000 villages.
- The claims of CFR rights in remaining villages will be covered from April 2013 to Sept. 2013.
- The CFR received will be corroborated from the records of Revenue & Forest department. April 2013.
- A joint campaign by field level functionaries of Tribal, Revenue & Forest department to identify FRCs at village level will take place during the above mention period.

# Habitat, Forest Villages, Pastoralists

- Recognition of Habitat rights of PTGs have been plan to be identified by February 2013.
- Forest villages, unrecorded settlements and old habitations will be identify from the census record.
- Conversion of forest villages in to revenue villages will be completed by June 2013 subject to repel of GOI Latter No. 23011/28/2008-SG-II Dated. 03.12.2008 & dated 01.09.2011.
- The recognition of rights of pastoralists and nomadic have been planned to be identified and recoded by March 2013 for the migrating nomadic groups from neighboring states.

# Individual Rights

- The number of GSs which are yet to claim individual rights [Sec.3(1)(a),(f),(g), and (m) ] is yet to be obtained.
- The GSs will be made aware of the fresh amendments and claims will be invited during December 2012 to May 2013.
- All the districts have been instructed to review the rejected claims of OTFDs which have been rejected due to insistence upon occupation over forest land for 75 years



# Protected areas

- List of National Park where process of recognition of rights have begun :- Kanha, Panna Tiger Reserve.
- Wild life Sanctuaries:- Bagdara, Bori, Sanjay Dubari, Gandhi Sagar, Gangau, Ghatigaon, Karera, Kuno Palpur, Nouradehi, Panpatha, Pench (Mowghli), Pen, Ratapani, Sardarppur, Kunopalpur
- List of National Park where process of recognition of rights is yet to begin :- Bandhavgarh, Pench Tiger Reserve, Madhav, Sanjay, Fossil, Khivni, Ralamandal, Veerangana Durgavati, bori, Phen, Narsinghgarh, Chambal, Orchha, Pachmarhi, Sailana, Singhori, Son Gharial,
- The processes will be completed by Sept. 2013

# **Action Plan for Grievance Redressal**

(As per MoTA Guidelines issued on 12.07.12)

- All the District Collectors have been instructed to create accessible grievance redressal system in the district to hear the cases such as non-provision of records, violation of rights, harassment etc.
- Monthly monitoring is being done by the Directorate of Tribal Area Development Planning. 300 Complaints were received at the TADP and got enquired by the collectors.

# Action Plan for Review of Rejection

- All the SDLCs are keeping records of claimants who have been informed about the rejection of their claims and the cases referred back to GSs for reconsideration and follow up action .
- The SDLCs have also been instructed to provide necessary evidences which may enable the claimants to get their grievances redressed.

# Strategy for Monitoring and Evaluation

- The monitoring of the implementation of FRA is continuously being done by Sub-Divisional Magistrate at SDLC, by Collectors at DLC and by the Chief Secretary of the state at SLMC
- In addition Commissioner, Tribal Area Development Planning monitors the implementation of FRA on monthly basis and continuously gives necessary instructions to all the functionaries concerned in districts to improve the status of implementation.
- Implementation of FRA is also being monitored by the Hon'ble Chief Minister in Quarterly Review Meetings.

# Strategy for Monitoring and Evaluation

- Setting up of a "Regional Monitoring Cell" to monitor the implementation of FRA in six northern states is proposed.
- The proposed "Regional Monitoring Cell" will be headed by a director in the rank of Principle Secretary.
- It will have 04 Additional Directors drawn from four departments viz. Tribal, Forest, Revenue & Panchayat of six states.
- Structure of the proposed cell is being submitted separately.

# Strategy for Post Recognition of Rights Support

- In all GSs a committee has been constituted to manage the forest resources under Rule 4(1) (e).
- The Forest Department will continuously train and impart awareness to the deed holders for conserving /managing the forest resources. This work will be done through a campaign in mission mode till Dec. 2013.
- The annual action plan of Forest Dept. will incorporate the special component for conservation and management of forest in the villages where FRs have been provided.

# Strategy for Post Recognition of Rights Support

- The deed holders are being benefited by development schemes being implemented under MANREGA, Indira Awas Yojana, Kapildhara Wells, lifting device for irrigation, Kisan Credit Cards and various other schemes meant for agriculture and animal husbandry.
- The deed holders will be given priority in all the other schemes which will accrue the benefit in their favor.
- Instructions have been issued to all collectors to converge all beneficiary oriented schemes in favour of deed holders vide latter no./1425/NREGS-MP/NR-16/2011 Dated - 9 Feb. 2011
- All the non - nationalized MFP are free from transit permit in the state.

# Final Commitments from the State

- After the verification and corroboration of rights recorded in the documents of Forest and Revenue department is completed by December 2013, more than 25000 community claims and more than 15000 individual claims are likely to be settled in this exercise.
