

Section - IX Right and Concessions :-

68. The following rights and concessions have been granted to cess paying tenants in Landakot, Kholgarh, Bahan, Khalasuni, Lardimal, Hatidhara and Rajl reserved forests.

- 1) They May take free of payment for their personal consumption only edible roots fruits and creepers.
- 2) They May take thatch grass on payment of one fourth of the scheduled or rates.
- 3) They may take bamboos at half the scheduled of rates.
- 4) Residents are permitted to graze animals upto the quota fixed for each block of payment of prescribed rates. The rates prescribed are :- (Vide F. F. A. H Department notification on-2577 dated 12-11-81).

69. The villages situated within the reserve and having no adequate village areas for grazing are allowed to graze their cattle in the reserved forests on the same condition as in protected forests, but they are given a definite area in which to pasture their cattle.

70. From Tal, Sanni, Nadia, Rengali-Badmal and Chargarh Reserved Forests ('B' class) the tenants are permitted to take timbers of unreserved species free from the coupes and reserved trees on payment of half the scheduled of rates for their own bonafide domestic consumption. Grazing is allowed on payment of the prescribed grazing fees subject to Silvicultural rules and control. Minor forest produce are allowed free for their own consumption. Similar rights exist in the protected forests where they are not subject to control.

71. In case of forests lying within Sonepur Sub Division of Bolangir District, the following rights and concessions have been admitted to cess paying tenants. Nistar cess or other cesses are collected from the tenants at the rate of Rs: 0.10 (Re: 0-1-6) per acre of paddy land and Rs. 0-06 (Re. 0-1-0) per acre of Aat land. These rights have been recorded in the report of the Forest Enquiry Committee, Orissa 1959 at page 123.

(1) In A class Reserve Forests :-

Grazing	—	No free grazing. But grazing is permitted at prescribed rate for the tenants and outsiders.

(2) In 'B' class Reserve Forests and D. P. Fs.

Timber	—	Unreserved species free. Reserved species on half royalty.
Fire-wood	—	Unreserved species free.
Bamboo	—	On full royalty.
M. F. P.	—	Fibre, Fruits, roots and leaves free. Sabia-grass, Tharch grass on full royalty.
Grazing	—	Free.

(3) In Khesra or unreserves or U. D. P. Fs.

Timber & Fire-wood	—	Same as in 'B' class R. Fs.
Bamboo	—	At full royalty.
M. F. P.	—	Same as in 'B' class R. Fs.
Grazing	—	Free.
